APPENDIX 2

DISCIPLINARY PROCESS QUICK REFERENCE GUIDE – CITING AND RED CARD CASES

Was it Foul Play (i.e. intentional/deliberate or reckless)? Did it warrant a red card?

- a. If No to one or both questions, case dismissed, player free to play.
- b. If Yes to both questions, case proceeds to sanction.



Sanctioning Stage 1: Was it Low-End, Mid-Range or Top-End based on the list of factors in Reg. 17.18.1 (see below)? See entry point in Sanction Table.

- intentional/deliberate
- reckless
- gravity of the actions
- nature of the actions, the manner in which the offence was committed including part of body used (for example, fist, elbow, knee or boot)
- existence of provocation premeditation
- retaliation (and timing)
- any other relevant feature of the conduct

- self-defence
- effect on the victim
- effect on the match
- vulnerability of the victim including part of victim's body involved/ affected, position of the victim, ability to defend him/herself
- level of participation in the offending and level of premeditation
- conduct completed or attempt



Sanctioning Stage 2: Are there any aggravating factors based on the list in Reg. 17.19.1 (see below)? If yes, consider increasing sanction above entry point.

- poor record
- need for general deterrent to combat pattern of offending in Game
- any other off-field aggravating factor(s)



Sanctioning Stage 3: Are there any mitigating factors based on the list in Reg. 17.20 (see below)? If yes, consider decreasing sanction (0-50% of entry point weeks).

- "guilty" plea (and timing)
- clean disciplinary record and/or good character
- youth and inexperience

- conduct prior to and at the hearing
- remorse/apology (and timing)
- any other off-field mitigating factor(s)

Deduct the % of the entry point (e.g., 25% of 4 week entry point = 1 week) from the sanction reached after stage 2 (e.g., 4 + 1 for aggravation - 1 for mitigation = 4 weeks)

If in a Low-End case there are mitigating factors but the suspension would be "wholly disproportionate" to the conduct, can reduce by



Sanctioning Stage 4: When does the sanction end?

- when is the player scheduled to play? (e.g., rest/injury periods, bye weeks, playoffs)
- are the matches all meaningful (e.g., pre-season 'friendlies', etc.)?
